ON LEASHES AT ALL TIMES**

All exhibitors and riders must be members of Arizona Horse Lovers Park \$5.00 day pass or \$35.00 annual membership (see www.azhorse loverspark.org)

In the performance classes, full & part-time TRAINERS and JUDGES will be allowed to show with a number in the English-Open & Western-Open classes only. They are not eligible for daily or year-end high point awards. They may show in the other classes WITHOUT BEING JUDGED. Final decision as to eligibility is up to show management. Chaps are optional. Hackamore or bosal may be used on a 6 & under horse in all classes (not mechanical)-2 hands permitted. Ponies are eligible in all classes. NO TRAINING EQUIPMENT allowed in classes. ALL RIDING CLASSES WILL BE RUN BY AQHA RULES.

HARD HATS REQUIRED IN ALL ENGLISH CLASSES, incl. schooling.
Safety helmets are permitted in Western classes and do not have to be of Western style.

NOVICE CLASSES - These classes are in the show as a complete division and year-end awards will be given. Exhibitors eligible as of January 1st will be allowed to show in this division at Blue Ribbon shows throughout the year. In "Novice Rider" classes, rider cannot have won more than 3 blue ribbons in that particular type of class at any shows. In "Novice Horse" classes, horse cannot have won more than 3 blue ribbons in that particular type of class at any shows. In "Novice Horse and Rider" classes, neither horse nor rider may have won more than 3 blue ribbons in that particular type of class at any shows. Final decision as to eligibility is up to show management.

*** WALK-TROT/JOG ALL AGES** - Exhibitors may show in other 3 gaited classes at this show.
WALK-TROT/JOG - 10 & UNDER & 11 & OVER DIVISIONS - These classes are open to those who cannot lope their horses. Final decision as to eligibility is up to show management. Exhibitors entered in these classes **may NOT show in any 3 gaited class at this show or any other show.**

LEADLINE - Children entered in this class may enter the 10 & Under-2 Gaited Showmanship and Trail, but no other classes. To be judged on equitation at a walk only.

RANCH HORSE Division classes: Conformation, Ranch Riding (with pattern), Ranch Rail Pleasure, Trail & Ranch Reining
AGE GROUPS - Go by your age as of January 1st.

SCORING SYSTEM - Classes with 6 or less entries - 1st = 6 pts. Classes with 7 or more entries - 1st = 8 pts. Ties will be broken by the highest placings - i.e. most firsts, etc.

POINT CARDS - It is the exhibitor's option to ask for a "point card" in place of a ribbon when the ribbons are handed out in the ring as placings are announced. These point cards entitle the bearer to \$1 each toward merchandise at Blue Ribbon Awards & Tack.

SHOW AWARDS - Trophy & ribbon to 1st and ribbons thru 6th place in all classes.

High Point trophies & Reserve High Point trophies (or optional gift certificates for High Point & Reserve) in each of the following divisions:

- Walk-Trot/Jog - 10 & Under-2 Gaited (English/Western Combined)
- Walk-Trot/Jog - 11 & Over-2 Gaited (English/Western Combined)
- Walk-Trot/Jog - All Ages-2 Gaited (English/Western Combined)
- 18 & Under-Western - English - 18 & Under
- 19 & Over-Western - English - Open (incl. pattern class)
- Novice Western-ALL AGES - Novice English - ALL AGES
- Western Open (incl pattern classes) - Ranch Horse Division (incl Reining class)

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR SHOW HIGH POINT AWARDS:

- for Walk-Trot/Jog English & Western combined - 10 & Under, 11 & Over & All Ages - High Points you must enter 3 out of the 4 to 6 classes offered in the division you are showing in.
 - for English High Points you must enter 2 out of the 3 classes offered in the division you are in.
 - for Western High Points you must enter 3 out of the 4 classes offered in the division you are in.
 - Halter Incentive: One Halter Class will now count towards a horse/exhibitor combination's Daily High Point awards & Year-End awards in 1 division, except Leadline. Horse must be same horse you're showing in that div. You MUST Specify which division/age group you want the Halter Points to count towards at each show!
- TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR YEAR-END AWARDS** - An exhibitor must have shown in that particular division under (9) judges minimum during the year & in at least 2 classes per show in that particular division. All of the Blue Ribbon Shows are double or triple judged/pointed.

YEAR-END AWARDS: Halter - Award to Champion through 6th place in each class, buckles to Grand Champion & Reserve.

All-Around Age Groups - Buckles to Champion & Reserve Champion, awards to 6th place in each division including Western Open & Ranch Horse divisions. **Special Leadline Year-End awards.**

2017's Year-End Awards Banquet will be held on February 18, 2018 (must be present to receive your award)
